God's Faithful Remnant of Israel

Romans 11:1-10

- 1) Israel has not been rejected by God.

"For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. The Lord your God has *chosen you* out of all the peoples on the face of the earth to be his people, his treasured possession." (Deuteronomy 7:6)

- 2) God in his grace has always provided a faithful God fearing remnant of Jewish people.
- 3) God never gives up on his people. He is faithfully reaching out to them through his remnant. God is slow to anger and abounding in love to his people. God has not rejected his people in the Old Testament or the New Testament.
- 4) God knew that there was going to be national unbelief in Israel; it was no surprise to him.
- 5) God is still reaching out to his people today.
- 6) God also has a plan for his chosen people Israel in the future (Romans 11:26).

Be genuinely friendly

Be grateful

Be careful with your terminology

Be Messiah-centric!
