Spiritual Gifts

Romans 12:3-8
Bill Richardson, Senior Pastor

Paul humbly serves Jesus as an apostle, offering his whole self as a 'living, holy sacrifice, pleasing to the Lord' on a daily basis. He spent his life doing this using his gifting.

Do you know what your spiritual gift is to serve the church?

There is a clear expectation, from both Jesus and the early church that we should spend our lives for God and be sacrificially serving him. We do this through the gifts that he has given us.

As Christians, we are united as a body under Christ. It is wrong to view ourselves as individuals who work in isolation. Our gifts are to be used collectively for the good of the body which is the church.

Do you think of yourself more highly than you ought? Are you jealous of another's gift?

- God gives gifts by the power of the Holy Spirit to every single believer.
- Each Christian has at least one gift which is for the building up of the church.
- The gifts he gives us, are to be used constantly.
- When God gives us a gift, he also gives us the strength and ability to use that gift.
- It is important for us to recognize our own gifting and be satisfied in that area of gifting.
- It is vital for us to use God's gifts for his ministry and not hide it.
- If we are not using our gifts then the church will be stunted in growth.

If you don't know what your gift is, ask the Holy Spirit to reveal it to you. Pray for opportunities to use the gift he is going to give you.
