Mark 11:1-10, Matthew 21, Luke 19

1. Recognizing the Time of His Gracious Coming
2. The Day Christ Wept for an Unready People
3. The Day Disciples and Children celebrated the Coming of God's Christ to Save and Rule

Luke 19:41-42, 44b As he approached Jerusalem and saw the city, he wept over it, and said, "If you, even you, had only **known on this day what would bring you peace**—but now it is hidden from your eyes. ... They will not leave one stone on another, **because you did not recognize the time of God's coming to you (episcopās, τὸν καιρὸν τῆς ἐπισκοπῆς σου.)**

1 Peter 2:12 Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation (*ἐν ἡμέρᾳ ἐπισκοπῆς*).
