The Transforming Power of God

Guest Speaker: Tom Kohl

Tom Kohl has served on the Washington County Circuit Court, State of Oregon and was the Presiding Judge from 2006-2010. Tom was President of the Oregon Circuit Court Judges Association from 2010-2011. Tom also helped to establish the first adult drug court in Washington County. On July 21, 2006, Tom's daughter, Megan was brutally murdered.

Tom's ministry Paid in Full Oregon <https://www.paidinfulloregon.org> provides Adults in Custody (AIC's) with a fully accredited bachelor's degree; transforming students into spiritual and moral leaders who will impact the entire prison population throughout the State of Oregon.

Luke 24:1-7
