### What is Peace?

- Peace in the Bible means “complete” or “whole”—“well-being in the widest sense.”

### How does one get this Peace?

- We obtain peace when we receive God's salvation by grace through faith in Jesus.
- We maintain peace when we live God's salvation by grace through faith in Jesus.

- As we celebrate Christmas, we worship the “Prince of Peace” (Isaiah 9:6).
