### **Luke 17:11-37 Ten Lepers and the Return of the Lord** **Bill Richardson – Senior Pastor**

v11-19 In this section we see Jesus healing ten lepers. However, after the healings occur, only one comes back to thank him.

Are you obedient to the words of Christ this morning?  
Has the Holy Spirit been asking you to do something?

The Samaritan throws himself at Jesus' feet which is an act of worship. Jesus commends him for having the right attitude of praise and thanksgiving.

Do you take the Lord Jesus for granted this morning?  
Do you thank and praise him when he answers your prayers?  
What can you thank him for today?

**Thank you Lord for \_\_\_\_\_. Praise your Holy Name.**

v20-21 Jesus is telling the Pharisees that 'the kingdom of God is within you.' Jesus as Messiah is right there among them.

v22-23 There are many false messiahs around today.

v24-25 "For the Son of Man in his day will be like the lightning, which flashes and lights up the sky from one end to the other." (see also 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10)

You are going to know when Jesus comes back; there will be no doubt about it.

Do you waste too much time thinking about the end times? (Matthew 24:36)

v25 Jesus is referring to his crucifixion which will have to come first.

v26-30 Before the Son of Man returns, people will act like they did in the days of Noah and Lot; they were completely oblivious to the impending doom and destruction. (Matthew 24:42-44)

Are you prepared for the 2nd coming of the Lord Jesus Christ?  
If Jesus were to return today, would he find you *watchful* for him?  
If you knew he was coming next week, what would you change?  
As a Christian, have you become complacent regarding your faith?  
When Christ comes will he find you lukewarm or on fire for him?  
What are you doing to serve your King and build his Kingdom?

v31-35 Jesus is coming back to take the believers with him. (1Thessalonians 4:16-17, Hebrews 9:28). There is judgment for those who do not believe in Christ.

If Jesus was to come back this morning would he take you with him or leave you to face judgment?  
How will he find you? (John 3:18)

v37 Jesus is vague here. Only God knows the time when Jesus is coming back and the exact location of the judgment.
