

Title: Zacchaeus: Social Leper to Son of Abraham  
Passage: Luke 19:1-10

### 5 Things to Know About Zacchaeus (besides the fact he was short)

1. He was a chief tax collector (19:2)
2. He was rich (19:2)
3. He was a sinner (19:7)
4. He was lost (19:10)

*“People without God are like lost sheep,*

*doomed to perish unless rescued by the shepherd.”* (New International Dictionary of New Testament Theology and Exegesis)

5. He became a son of Abraham (19:9)

*Like the Apostle Paul (1 Timothy 1:16), Zacchaeus became a trophy of GRACE —an example of the power of Jesus Christ to seek and to save the lost.*

### Who is your “Zacchaeus”?

1. Will you pray for them?
2. Will you spend time with them?
3. Will you recognize how God is working in their life?
4. Will you help them get closer to Jesus?

*“Your relationship with a lost person may be the only road that will take that person to the cross.”* (Ron Hutchcraft, *A Life That Matters*)
