- This section (1:27-2:18) contains 7 imperative verbs (i.e. commands) that relate to each other and include explanations.

4. Work out your own salvation (2:12)	Follow Christ's model of humble, selfless, God-fearing _____.

6. Be glad and Rejoice with me (2:18)	Maintain a unified and resolute _____ in the present and future realities of the gospel.
