vs12: Paul is thankful to Jesus for the provision of strength for the ministry. **Paul recognizes that Jesus Christ has appointed him to his service.** As believers in Jesus Christ, we too have been appointed to his service (John 15:16).

- What are you doing to serve the Lord?

v13: Paul gives a brief testimony (Acts 26:9-11).

v14: Paul was shown mercy, grace, faith and love in Christ Jesus.
