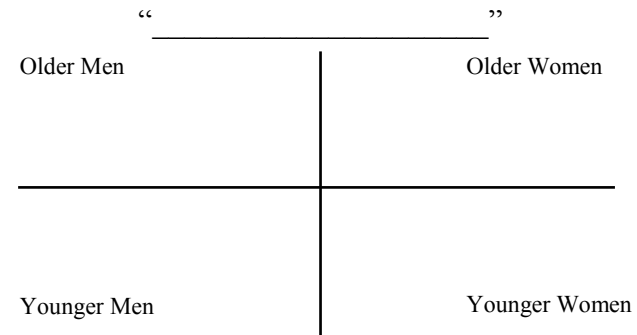

Giving Correction to God's Household (1 Timothy 5:1-2):



Two Words on Purity:

1. Purity is THE moral standard in God's family. If this is a sin in your life, then you need to confess it (Prov. 28:13; 1 John 1:9).
2. One strategy to resist impurity is to change how you view others. They are not objects of lust; they are God's creation and gift. We are brothers and sisters in the family of God.
